Safari only works on Apple devices, however, the following browsers can be used on an Apple computer:

- Google Chrome
- Mozilla Firefox
- Opera
- Vivaldi

In recent years, Safari has become a serious competitor with other browsers. It now has many of the same features as others such as Chrome.

- Sleeker design
- Tabs, pinning of tabs, tab overview
- Click in address bar to see favorite websites
- Combination address-search bar
- A 'Reader View' option
- Customizable tool bar
- Bookmarks sidebar
- Sharing with others via mail, text message, social media
- With El Capitan version of Safari, can save to iCloud
- In Sierra version, copy then paste to another Apple device

Bottom Line

Staying with Safari is an excellent browser for the vast majority of Apple users and with every update Safari gets better and better.

If you feel that you should have a separate backup browser or that you want even more in a browser then my suggestion is to download Chrome and place the shortcut to it in the dock.
