

Suggested Mozilla Firefox Installation Procedure

The following procedure has been developed to assist Willow Valley Residents in installing Mozilla Firefox as their default Internet browser. Depending on a Resident's computer type and operating system, different displays may be presented when installing Firefox. In the browser address box enter: <http://www.mozilla.org/en-US/firefox/new/> and press Enter

Left-click in the area where **Firefox Free Download** is displayed

Run the set up and allow changes to be made to your computer

Follow the instructions in the Mozilla Firefox Setup Wizard

Use the standard setup

Left-click in the box to use Firefox as the default web browser another

Left-click the Install button

Left-click the Finish button

Import Options, Bookmarks, History, Passwords and other data from another browser, if desired

Left-click in the circle to Import your home page from another browser, if desired

Left-click Finish

[To avoid the Firefox Welcome screen, left-click on the "home" icon]

Close Firefox

You don't need to ok their collection of additional data or to get their email

If you see Firefox toolbars you don't want or you don't see toolbars with icons such as the printer icon that you do want, right-click in a blank area of one of the toolbars at the top of the screen, then left-click to check or uncheck items in the pulldown menu. Repeat that process until you get the desired displays.

To put a Firefox desktop icon that takes you to a Web site or page while using Firefox, put the mouse pointer/cursor on the small icon that is at the left of the address in the address box, hold down the left mouse button, and drag that icon to the computer desktop, then release the left mouse button.
