

# Low Vision Help for Kiosk Users

The following information is provided to assist Residents with low vision in using Willow Valley Kiosk units.

## To Turn High Contrast Displays On

Simultaneously hold down the left Alt key (the Alt key on the left side of the keyboard) AND the left Shift key (the Shift key that makes capital letters that is on the left side of the keyboard) AND press the Print Screen key (the Print Screen key is at the top right side of the keyboard and may be abbreviated and shared with other markings). When a pop-up asks if you want to turn on High Contrast, left-click on the **Yes** button.

## To Turn High Contrast Displays Off

Simultaneously hold down the left Alt key (the Alt key on the left side of the keyboard) AND the left Shift key (the Shift key that makes capital letters that is on the left side of the keyboard) AND press the Print Screen key (the Print Screen key is at the top right side of the keyboard and may be abbreviated and shared with other markings).

## To Turn the Screen Magnifier On

Hold down the Windows Logo key (the key with the four windows images at the bottom left of the keyboard) and press the + key (the plus key is usually at the far right of the keyboard on the numeric keypad). Repeating that action will increase the magnification. Pressing the minus key (usually next to the plus key) will reduce the magnification.

## To Exit the Screen Magnifier

Hold down the Windows Logo key (the key with the four windows images at the bottom left of the keyboard) and press the Escape key (the key with ESC at the upper left of the keyboard).

## Reminder

Don't forget to Restart the Kiosk unit when you begin your session and when you end your session so no malicious software will be present between sessions and your settings will not confuse subsequent Kiosk users.
